The Twelve Laws that Govern Health and Healing The Woman with the Issue of Blood

Course 13 Lesson 2

Scriptures

Mark 5:25-34 Now a certain woman had a flow of blood for twelve years, 26 and had suffered many things from many physicians. She had spent all that she had and was no better, but rather grew worse. 27 When she heard about Jesus, she came behind Him in the crowd and touched His garment. 28 For she said, "If only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well." 29 Immediately the fountain of her blood was dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of the affliction. 30 And Jesus, immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone out of Him, turned around in the crowd and said, "Who touched My clothes?" 31 But His disciples said to Him, "You see the multitude thronging You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?" 32 And He looked around to see her who had done this thing. 33 But the woman, fearing and trembling, knowing what had happened to her, came and fell down before Him and told Him the whole truth. 34 And He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed of your affliction."

Twelve is a picture of the twelve tribes of Israel.

The flow of blood is a picture of the curse of the Law (Deuteronomy 28:61).

The Law of Moses had brought everyone under the curse of the Law (Galatians 3:10)

The moment she touched God's righteousness and grace she was forgiven of her sins. The moment she was forgiven, the judgment for sin (the curse of the Law) could no longer stay in her body. She was transformed from, "a certain woman", to "Daughter". Her faith in Jesus transformed her from a servant of God to a child of God.

Malachi 4:2 But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With healing in His wings; And you shall go out And grow fat like stall-fed calves.

God instructed the children of Israel to put four tassels at the corners of their garments. This tassel was to have a blue thread in it (*Numbers 15:38*). The Hebrew word for tassel is "tseetseeth"; and it means a floral or wing-like projection, i.e. a forelock of hair, a tassel: The Jewish people called these tassels "wings".

The blue thread in the tassel is a picture of God's grace.

When she touched the Sun of Righteousness wings she was healed.

When you touch the grace of our risen Savior you too will be healed.

This woman did not base her faith on her righteousness or her good deeds. She based her faith on God's love and compassion for her. It is God's amazing grace that heals us not our actions.

Our faith in God's love and goodness is what brings the healing and miracle that we need into our lives.
