Day Twenty Three

(Is it always God's will to heal?)

Most all Christians believe that God can heal, for he is the Almighty God and there is nothing impossible for him. However, many Christians are not sure if it is God's will to heal them. Jesus is the exact image of God the Father. He said he came not to do his will but the will of him who sent him. Jesus went around doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil for God was with him. Jesus said he was the resurrection and the life. Every recorded incident were Jesus came in contact with a dead person he raised them from the dead. There is no record in the Gospels of someone coming to Jesus and not being healed or delivered.
