## Day Two

(Born Sinners)

The Bible is an inspired book written by men who were moved by the Holy Spirit. It is a book that tells the story of God's great love for man. God created man in his image and likeness. God created a beautiful garden for man to live in. God placed two special trees in the Garden of Eden, the Tree of Life and the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. He instructed Adam not to eat from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. Satan deceived Adam and his wife Eve to eat from the forbidden tree. Jesus bore our judgment for sin and died on the cross so that we could bare his righteousness and receive his abundant life. Jesus bore our sicknesses, diseases, and pains so that we could bear his health and long life. On the cross Jesus cried out, "My God, My God why have you forsaken me", so that we can cry out My Father, My Father why have you loved me.

Heavenly Father I thank you for loving me so much you sent me a Savior, your only Begotten Son. I thank you Jesus for bearing my sins and giving me your perfect righteousness as a free gift.
